To Whom It May Concern:

The running joke among students and faculty on campus at Westminster College was that the school "reeked of learning," as anyone walking on the footpath near the grease interceptor would be overwhelmed by the foul odor. The odor was due to grease and other food materials from the food service areas collecting and thriving in the facility grease trap.

We tried several remedies to the odor and solids collection problem, including reducing the water temperature to help slow the development of the odor, which then required the added cost of a dish dryer to be installed in the kitchen. Disinfection and emulsion chemicals, such as oxidizers and enzymes, were also employed to no avail as they were just sending our problems down-stream to the city. With fines and penalties looming from the city, we were introduced to the Compliance product line by Alpine Technical Services.
